Child Protection Education Term 3

Child Protection lessons and activities are an important component of K-6 education in all NSW schools. During Term 3 children in Kindergarten to Year 6 will participate in

Child Protection lessons either as part of their PD/H/PE activities or specific Child Protection lessons. These lessons aim to assist children in developing skills in:

- Recognising and responding to unsafe situations.
- Strengthening attitudes and values related to equality, respect and responsibility.
- Recognising appropriate and inappropriate behaviours.

Child Protection education incorporates teaching and learning in 3 broad themes:

- Recognising abuse.
- Power in relationships.
- Protective strategies.

Lessons can deal with sensitive issues. All children must feel safe, comfortable and confident when dealing with Child Protection issues. If you have any questions or concerns about your child participating in Child Protection activities please contact your class teacher or the school, as soon as possible.
