COVID 19 Update

Advice for schools around COVID has been updated in line with advice from NSW Health. Key updates include:

- Where possible students are to stay within their cohort group (class, year group or stage) for all learning and extra-curricular activities, including sports, arts and physical activities.
- Schools need to remind parents and staff NOT to attend school if they are unwell, even if they have mild symptoms. Arrangements must be made to send students home if they are exhibiting flu like symptoms.
- o Schools should encourage anyone who is unwell to be COVID tested.
- o The school needs to sight negative COVID test results before allowing staff and students to return to school if they have been unwell with flu like symptoms.
- School assemblies may continue but must be limited to15 minutes and cohorts of students are kept together. There should be no external visitors including parents and carers.
- Additional restrictions on all interschool activities, including debating, sports or other activities organised or sponsored by the school.
- o Group singing/chanting and playing of wind instruments in groups are no longer permitted.
- o A small number of school activities remain on hold until further notice, such as Kinder Orientation.

The prevention of the spread of COVID is everyone's responsibility, we all need to be vigilant with regard to hygiene practices and social distancing.
