Call Essential Energy on 13 20 80 if you see fallen or damaged powerlines — ember to stay at least at metres away from the line and anything in contact with it!

Identify hazardous areas



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Never try to use an object to reach for or touch a powerline. If you see something in contact with our powerlines, like a tree branch, call 13 20 80 to report the



Emergency escape

- Stay in your vehicle and call 000 immediately
- If escape is absolutely necessary, jump well clear to avoid contact with the vehicle and ground at the same time
- When you jump, land with your feet together. Do not touch the vehicle, fall or allow your feet to step apart
- You must shuffle or jump, with your feet together until you are at least 8 metres clear of the vehicle, powerline or anything else in contact with them
- Once clear, do not return to the vehicle for any reason
- Call Essential Energy on 13 20 80
- Remember to never approach a vehicle to assist in an evacuation and always treat powerlines as if they
