- Each school rehearses separately then together for a final rehearsal prior to the finale.

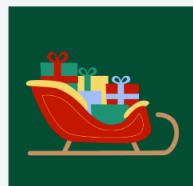

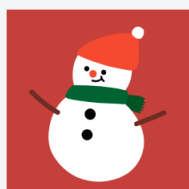
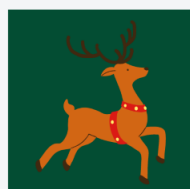
