Athletics Carnival Information

All children are eligible to compete in 800m and 1500m events. There are divisions for junior, 11yrs and senior. Trials for 200m, long jump, high jump, shot put and discus have been conducted and only children who have qualified for these events will compete on the day. Ribbons will be handed out for all field and running events. Don't forget to **dress up in your house colours**, bring a banner and streamers to represent your house.

While staff will complete an additional aspect of training, developing their knowledge of anaphylaxis support, the students will focus on understanding and performing the steps involved how to administer CPR correctly.

We are very proud of the role our school plays in supporting our YR 6 students to access these important life safety skills, as we are one of a few schools across the state that offer this training to their students.

I extend an invitation to any family whose child has lost an item of clothing or a drink bottle to pop into the school office and inspect items collected over the term.


School Cross Country
