Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

This Friday at 11:30am, the school along with community members will participate in a Sorry Day Service that will be coordinated by Miss Kira Parsons.

Sorry Day carries great significance for The Stolen Generation, the very word 'sorry' is used to express sorrow at the loss of a loved one by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples, usually when someone passes away. When using the word 'sorry' in the context of The Stolen Generations, the word represents the grief and loss experienced by the parents, families and communities of the children who were forcibly removed. The service is an opportunity for staff and community members to celebrate the strength and survival of these people, and to share in the process of healing and reconciliation.
