

# Borambola Sport and Recreation Centre

## Year 6 Day Excursion

Dear Parent / Guardian,

COVID-19 has resulted in many activities at school being cancelled, one of which is our four-day excursion to Canberra. To ensure our senior students are given every opportunity to build memories during their last year at South, we have been able to secure a last-minute booking to the Borambola Sport and Recreation Centre, after another school cancelled their overnight visit. The only hiccup, is the only available dates for all of Term 4, are the first five days of Term 4. With this in mind, we have opted to travel to the facility on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> October.

- Venue:** Borambola Sport and Recreation Centre  
1980 Sturt Highway, Borambola NSW 2650 (Just outside of Wagga)
- Date:** Friday 16<sup>th</sup> October
- Times:** Depart Friday 16<sup>th</sup> October at 6.00am  
Return Friday 16<sup>th</sup> October at approximately 8.00pm
- Transport:** Dyson's Bus Service
- Cost:** \$75 per student (Due to time constraints, payment can be made online or brought into the Front Office, by the close of Wednesday the 14<sup>th</sup> October.)
- Uniform:**
- Casual clothes can be worn for travel, archery and BMX riding.
  - A second set of clothes for the mud run, along with an old pair of shoes. (Students will shower after the run, so will need a towel and toiletries and a plastic bag for wet clothes)
  - Covered shoes must be worn. Strictly no thongs.

**Recess/lunch:** Will be provided by the facility; however, students may bring additional snacks to munch on, whilst on the bus. Strictly no lollies. Students are to bring their own drink bottle/s.

**Online Registration:** Borambola require each registrant (children and adults) to complete an online registration form. This information is essential to enable the site to accommodate special requirements and needs. Having filled in the form ourselves, it will ask for a name, contact information, details of any medical conditions/allergies and food intolerances. This form is compulsory and must be completed to attend. **Please note Chrome is their preferred internet browser.**
